1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted with changes as reflected below.

2. Adoption of the minutes

The minutes were adopted without changes.

3. ICSC training local salary survey

To build capacity in preparation of the upcoming local salary survey, the Bureau acted on the Council's decision to nominate two persons to attend and selected Philip Thomas and Cintia Cardoso.

4. CCISUA delegation

The Bureau acted on the Council's, decision to send three people to the CCISUA mid-term meetings and three people for lobbying. Accordingly, it nominated the ES, President and Nataliya Oliynyk for the meeting from 18 to 21 November and the ES, President and DES for lobbying from 18 to 26.

5. Time release for Staff Management Groups

Because of downsizing associated with UN80, at least five Geneva entities would have SMGs composed of 3 staff representatives. As this would not be possible under the current time release framework, it was agreed to raise the matter at SMC.

6. Any other business

The Bureau was briefed on SMC. Regarding roster expiry, the strategy was to concentrate on legal challenges.

The meeting was adjourned at 2.00 p.m.
