#### 1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted without changes.

#### 2. Adoption of the minutes

#### 3. CCISUA and lobbying

The ES reported on the agenda for the mid-term meetings and the EB discussed the need to have meetings with a wide range of delegations. Lobbying would focus on UN80/funding and the common system.

#### 4. New staff rules

A new version of the Staff Rules had been issued without any consultation through SMC. It was agreed to raise the matter in SMC and inform staff through a broadcast.

#### 5. Bike parking

FMS was proposing to take bike parking away from the front of H building, but all members of the Green Mobility group opposed the idea. It was reiterated that the Staff union position was to keep bike parking directly in front of the building and even increase it but not to oppose ideas for new parking locations.

#### 6. Official holidays 2027

It was agreed to raise no objection to the proposed official holidays, which were in line with the usual pattern.

## **8. UNFCU presentation**
